Attention News Directors and Assignment Editors:

Digging season is now fully underway in Saskatchewan, after an unusually long winter delayed much of this work. As a result of this activity, Sask 1st Call, on Tuesday of this week, experienced an all-time record in the number of line locate requests for a single day.

Sask 1st Call received 1,361 locate requests – 169 more than the previous record set in 2012. Unfortunately, not all the people/companies engaging in ground disturbance activities are requesting line locates, as there have been reports of a high number of line hits over the last two weeks where there has been no line locate requested.

Sask 1st Call is a service for anyone planning to dig or excavate. The service provides a free underground facility screening and notification for excavators. Sask 1st Call and its member companies are dedicated to the prevention of unnecessary damage, injury or death due to unsafe digging practices. We look forward to serving you for your own safety, and that of our communities.
